




PANEL DESCRIPTIONS

Front Panel



- 1) DC 5V
- 2) When switch to "ARC", the indicator will turn green
- 3) When switch to "2.0 audio", the indicator will turn green
- 4) When switch to "5.1 audio", the indicator will turn green
- 5) HDMI inputs
- 6) IR receiver windows
- 7) Switch for source selection
- 8) Switch to ARC
- 9) Switch to 2.0ch/5.1ch audio/Auto 1
- 10) Power indicator
- 11) Power on/off switch
- When the "2.0" indicator and "5.1" indicator are off, it's by pass audio mode.

Back Panel



- 1) HDMI inputs
- 2) HDMI output (Support ARC)
- 3) SPDIF Audio output
- 4) Analog Audio output


Connecting and Operating

1. Audio Extraction connection

- 1) Connect the HDMI signal sources (Such as PS3, STB etc) into HDMI input of HDMI Switch.
- 2) Connect the HDMI display device (such as: HD-LCD, HD-DLP) into HDMI output of HDMI Switch.
- 3) Connect optical audio cable or RCA audio cable to Amplifier.
- 4) Connect DC 5V power to the HDMI Switch.

Attention: Insert/Extract cable gently

Application Diagram




2. ARC Connection

- 1) Make sure the display support ARC
- 2) Connect the HDMI signal sources (Such as PS3, STB etc) into HDMI TV.
- 3) Connect HDMI TV to the output of HDMI Switch.
- 4) Connect optical audio cable or RCA audio cable to Amplifier.
- 5) Connect DC 5V power to the HDMI Switch.

MAINTENANCE

Clean this unit with a soft, dry cloth. Never use alcohol, paint thinner of benzine to clean this unit.

PRODUCT SERVICE

- 1) Damage requiring service: The unit should be serviced by qualified service personnel if:
- (a) The DC power supply cord or AC adaptor has been damaged;
- (b)Objects or liquids have gotten into the unit;
- (c)The unit has been exposed to rain;
- (d) The unit does not operate normally or exhibits a marked change in performance;
- (e)The unit has been dropped or the cabinet damaged.
- 2) **Servicing Personnel**: Do not attempt to service the unit beyond that described in these operating instructions. Refer all other servicing to authorized servicing personnel.
- 3) **Replacement parts:** When parts need replacing ensure the servicer uses parts specified by the manufacturer or parts that have the same characteristics as the original parts. Unauthorized substitutes may result in fire, electric shock, or other hazards.

WARRANTY

If your product does not work properly because of a defect in materials or workmanship, our Company (referred to as "the warrantor") will , for the length of the period indicated as below,

(Parts(2)Year ,Labor(90) Days) which starts with the date of original purchase ("Limited Warranty period"), at its option either(a) repair your product with new or refurbished parts, or (b) replace it with a new of a refurbished product. The decision to repair or replace will be made by the warrantor.

During the "Labor" Limited Warranty period there will be no charge for labor.

During the "Parts" warranty period, there will be no charge for parts. You must mail-in your product during the warranty period. This Limited Warranty is extended only to the original purchaser and only covers product purchased as new. A purchase receipt or other proof of original purchase date is required for Limited Warranty service.

Mail-In Service

When shipping the unit carefully pack and send it prepaid, adequately insured and preferably in the original carton. Include a letter detailing the complaint and provide a day time phone and/or email address where you can be reached.
